MEDICAL MISSIONS 2024

WITH ICMM we had the following programs in 2024:

- Medical services for Artsakh immigrants, providing free medical care
- Helping poor families with Medical care
- Dental services for Artsakh and poor families
- Providing some medicine for treatment
- Outreach mission to Armenian regions
- Presenting medical missions in Armenia in ICCC Sri Lanka Christian Medical congress, Korea

Working with Artsakh immigrants, taking care their physical and spiritual needs as many of them besides of having physical issues also were depressed and hopeless. They had lost their homeland, houses, possession, work and history. So, only Physical care was not enough for them. More than one year we have been taking care of them. Most of them had spine, joint problems and one of them has developed Parkinson disease as well. They came to Yerevan without anything, they were not allowed even to take their cloths from home, All of them were led to Christ and received New Testament and through help of a church also blankets. Some pics bellow! All these people were high educated people , In the picture left side lady used to be headmaster of school, next to her was scientist, third was specialist of Armenian language and literature, the last one was teacher as well. None of them are employed now. Due to their health issues they received more than 150 different procedures. **Some medicine for patients' treatment also have been provided. The lady on the right in the second picture** was not able to walk because of knee arthrosis and Arthritis so Hyaluronic acid was bought and intraarticular injected.








Dental services

Helping poor families with Medical care

There was a Christian man with 5 children whose hand was cut because of window was broken. So he had surgery but for rehab didn't afford so with 10 and more procedures we helped. When he came he was able to open his hand, 3 forearm nerves were cut and sutured after 10 procedures with laser, electro, magneto therapy and osteopathy, and he was able to open his fingers and hand. Praise the Lord!



Outreach mission to Armenian regions


9 outreach missions were managed in 2024, in Syunik: Meghri, Goris, Kapan, Sisian for 6 days and Ararat region: Darakert/Masis, Taperakan, Ararat village. Total 9 visits and total 739 patients. In our team we had Endocrinologist, Cardiologist, Gynecologists, Neurologist, Pediatrician, General Practitioner, and MSK specialist: Doctor of Physiotherapy, Kinesiotherapy, Vertebrology, Manual therapy etc.

We started from Syunik 400kg far from Yerevan

Syunik is the spine for Armenia and the gate to Armenia from Iran. One of oldest and most beautiful place in southern part of Armenia at the border with Iran, with Artsakh (which is now occupied by Azeries). People were asking us to visit them frequently and feeling themselves isolated. They need a lot our physical presence as doctors and spiritual support. That is why we decided to start from Syunik. A lady from Armenian Diaspora: Mrs. Ani Zatikian (Founder of "Remedy for Needy" organization) joined us and funded in outreach missions to Syunik, it was quite expensive trip. Jacob Pursley's group of US missionaries volunteered us in Meghri taking patients from far villages by their cars to the clinics.

Thirst 3 days visit were in Kapan and Meghri.

Total cases in Outreach missions is 739: 165 spine and joint patients, 170 heart and blood pressure issues, 143 Thyroid, Diabetes patients, 82 Gynecology problems, 8 Neurology, brain circulation issues, 21 pediatric patients, 150 Therapeutic cases.
